NOW ROOZ 3751

Now Rooz Farkhondeh Baad Now Rooz Khojasteh Baad

We are entering the 3751st year since Zarathushtra celebrated the vernal equinox with King Gostasp of Balkh. Thirteen years later, Zarathushtra was in his planetarium near Lake Hamoun in Sistan when his calculation revealed that the vernal equinox of 1725 BCE would coincide with sunrise in Sistan in the kingdom of Balkh. In other words the new year (equinox) and the new day (sunrise) would start at the same time. He named that New Year - New Day-NOW ROOZ.

Thereafter any year that the sunrise coincided with the equinox in Greater Persia it was called Now Rooz. One such event was recorded at Persepolis in 487 BCE. Persian scholars had pre-

calculated and King Daryush had built the Apadana Palace to specification and placed a square stone at the entrance.

Everyone had gathered in their best attire and was waiting the moment of the equinox. Just when the equinox was proclaimed the first rays of the rising sun lit the square stone. This was a rare occasion and dignitaries from all over the Empire had come to see and pay their respect to the **Science of the Persians**. We see that depicted in bas relief all over Takht e Jamshid.

The Now Rooz of 3751 (2013) will happen in New York Where the Equinox and the Sunrise will coincide at 7.02 am on March 20, 2013. In Quebec and Ontario Canada there will be about a minute lapse between the two events.

THE NOW ROOZ TABLE

THE ANCIENT PHILOSOPHY OF THE NOW ROOZ TABLE HAFT SEENE – THE SEVEN TRAYS

Do you know that "SHARAB" (wine) is an Arabic word that the Persian words for wine are MAI and BAADEH.

This by itself proves that the "Seen" and "Sheen" theory is a modern one. So what is the Real philosophy?

In ancient times they used to have Seven Trays – SEENE – in which they laid all sorts of symbolic items that were available locally in each region. This SEENE (tray) in modern days became the alphabet SEEN and SHEEN and items whose names started with those letters were placed on the table. The Zarathushties used the letter SHEEN for they put on their table Wine – SHARAB – (Arabic for wine) while the Muslims for whom wine was forbidden went for items with SEEN and instead put vinegar – SERKEH.

The form of the Now Rooz table has evolved with time but what has remained constant is the number Seven. We also see in the bas-relief at Takht e Jamshid seven representatives of each nation carrying Now Rooz gifts for the king. Why Seven?

THE REAL PHILOSOPHY



Seven represents the "Seven Eternal Laws of Nature" as enumerated in the Gathas.

- 1-*VOHU MANA Good Mind –* Use your Good Mind to inquire and learn
- 2- ASHA VAHISTA- The Ultimate Truth- the Laws of Nature- Use them to make
- 3- KASH ATRA VAIRYA Good Rules Good Laws- Good Guidance- Which will lead to
- 4- SEPANTA ARMAITY Lawful Desire Righteousness which will pave the way towards
- 5- HURVATATA Perfection Mental, Physical and Spiritual which will lead to

6- AMERETATA – Immortality –a) Losing the fear of Death (b) being remembered for your good work for generations–resulting in oneness with

7- AHURA MAZDA – The Creator of Wisdom – through Self Realization- KHOD = Self AH = to come.

So it does not matter as long as there are 7 items or better still 7 trays with numerous items, it serves as a reminder and our re-commitment to the Natural Path towards perfection shown by Zarathushtra.

Students of Zarathushtra latter called it the Amesha Sepanta - the ETERNAL LAW - much

later under pagan influence they became Angels, Bountiful Immortals, etc. those trying to rescue it call it "attributes of God". The 3 gifts that the Magi's gave to baby Jesus were the first three laws, which have to be achieved; the next 4 are the result of the first 3. It is the evolutionary law followed by nature. A law to achieve perfection in what we do best and at the same time satisfies the spiritual urge through Khod-Ah.

SADEH CELEBRATION

SAAD means 100 in Persian and Sadeh is the celebration of the 100th Day of Winter as celebrated by our ancient Aryans ancestors when they lived in the Arctic region. In the Arctic they had 5 months of winter and 7 months of summer. Their winter began on the 1st of ABAN (23 of October) so 30 days of Aban 30 days of Azar, 30 days of Dey and on the 10th of Bahman (30 January) they celebrated Sadeh. (9 days in October + 30 in November +31 in December +30 in January = 100).

Sadeh marked the start of the preparation for the farming in spring. People would go on roof tops or mountain tops and light fires signalling their neighbours of the advent of Sadeh. Even today farmers in Yazd after the celebration of Sadeh start preparing their farms for spring.

Sadeh is a link to our history, it is to remind us of our ancient history of where our ancestors came from and of how ancient our history is.

Later other events in history some mythical, were connected to Sadeh, like the discovering of how



to light a fire by Hoshang the Pishdadian Shah. Who according to Shahnameh threw a stone to kill a dragon and instead hit another stone and sparked a fire, thus discovering how to light a fire.

There is also some wrong information due to lack of knowledge associated by scholars to Sadeh, like saying that the 100 of the Sadeh comes from 50 nights and 50 days to Now Rooz. This theory does not have any significance and is not true.

In modern days the lighting of fire has been given more significance than the historic significance of Sadeh and its link to our ancient history.

We also got together on January 26th and celebrated Sadeh with delicious home-made foods and desserts, laughed, and danced till midnight. Thank you to participants that made such a great night.

NEW YORK, February 11, 2013--Scientists Without Borders and the Sackler Institute for Nutrition Science, both programs of the New York Academy of Sciences, partnered with DSM's humanitarian nutrition think tank, Sight and Life, to announce the winners of their open innovation challenge seeking More Sustainable and Effective Approaches for Delivering Micronutrient Powders (MNPs).

In their press release "Scientists without boarders" announced **Dr. Mehrdad Keshmiri** from Port Moody, BC, Canada as the 3rd prize winner.

The panelists chose the winning solutions from research project submissions that were generated from 15 countries over 90 days. Current foil sachets, which are used in 200 million MNP packets for distribution of critical supplements to 2 billion people worldwide, cannot be recycled, repurposed or composted. The competition sought innovative ideas for more sustainable and effective nutrient packaging solutions.

She currently studies at the University of Toronto and is in her final year of a Master of Information program specializing in Information Systems & Design and Knowledge & Information Management.
